Nor can men and women of AA ever forget that only through suffering did they find enough humility to enter the portals of that New World.

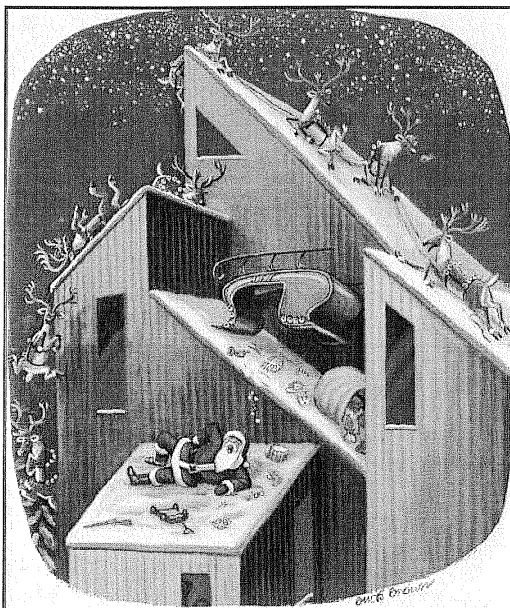

Knowing its full worth and purpose, we can no longer fear adversity, we have found prosperity where there was poverty, peace and joy have sprung out of the very midst of chaos.

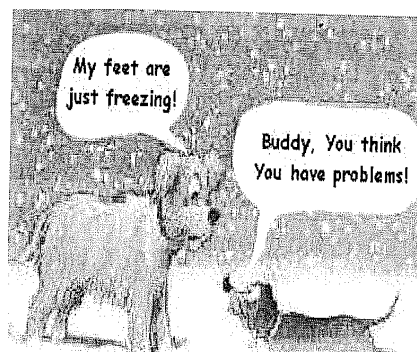
Great indeed, our blessings!

Monday, September 22, 2008, 6:00 P.M.

Approve Previous Month's Minutes: Approved except as noted. New chair for outreach committee is Debbie from Goliad group, not Serendipity.

Announcements: Virginia reported the 7th annual Day in Recovery fundraiser for CSO is coming up. Char reported CSO was in need of assistance with the website. Nov. 17th is the tentative date for the CSO Open House.

Financial Report: Linda reported – Total contributions down and lack of sales. Big loss this month.

Some of the expense this month included: re-keying the office doors \$110, copier expense \$55, dumpster service (3 months) \$63.15, sobriety \$priceless\$. Depreciation should stay the same for a while. Still looking for someone to do a financial inventory. Just enough to make sure everything is recorded and reported accurately.

CSO Board Liaison Report: A/C was fixed by the landlord – no cost! Gratitude boxes are being assembled for donations in November. Meeting space is being used; District 16 meets here, archives interviews.

There was a request from the Al-Anon community to sell some of the more-requested literature. AA and Al Anon literature would not be co-mingled – Al Anon would be in its own separate and distinct location. We would need permission from Al Anon World Services and a \$400 initial investment.

Laura G. is the new translator for SAMSO. There will also be a flyer in Spanish about the basics of CSO. The board voted to allow SAMSO to have info on CSO website, or to have a link.

Telephone Service Report: No report given.

Archives Committee Report: No report given.

Outreach Committee Report: First official “gig” was cancelled. The Outreach Committee informs groups and individuals about CSO and its activities and promotes the Nightcap.

Old Business: Nomination forms for Board of Directors positions are due by October 1st. Turn them in to Donna from Serendipity, Debbie from Goliad, or Paul from Community group, or to Char or Vicki at the CSO office.

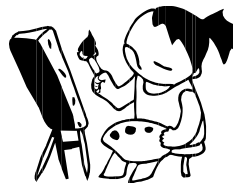
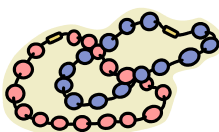
