



Communication is up due to paying three months at a time. Postage was \$216.45 mainly due to sending out the gratitude boxes, but is worth it since it brought in over \$2,000 last year. Volunteer recognition was up because of gifts for Christmas. \$\$ also came in from Family Fun Fair & Weekend in SA registrations.

CSO Board Liaison Report: In Linda's absence, Char reported the CSO would be closed the 27th and 28th for the Thanksgiving holiday, and would only be open until 1:00 PM on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve, and closed Christmas Day.

Art and Daniel are adding SAMSO information to the website. It will contain the same information given out over the phone to the public at the CSO. There has been a computer donated for the volunteer's desk that will help them be more efficient when answering questions over the phone. Online store is up and running.

Al-Anon will not allow CSO to be a distributor of literature, but CSO will still carry the literature purchased at retail. Big Book price will increase one or two dollars in the near future.


Telephone Service Report: No report given.


