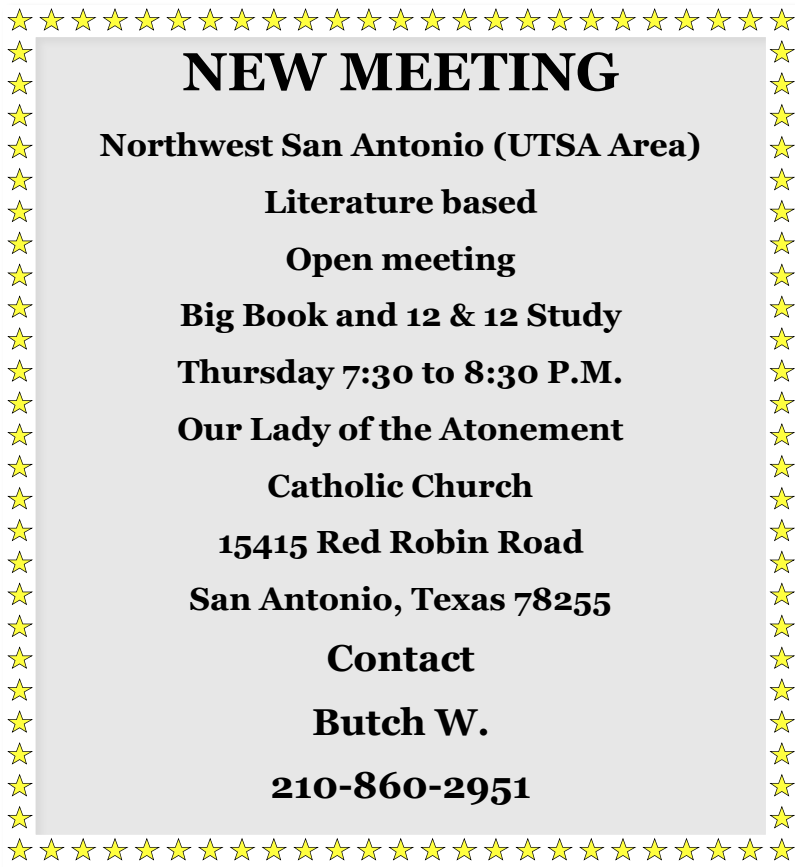

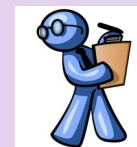

## The purpose of the CFC is to:

**Assist and coordinate** the efforts of individual AA members and groups in San Antonio who want to carry the AA message to inmates.

- ❖ **Provide AA literature** to inside AA members and groups. (Big Books, 12 and 12's, and Daily Reflections.)
- ❖ **Facilitate a “sponsor by mail” service** to offer inside AA members written communication with outside members, which is especially important if there is no AA meeting in their facility. The correspondence is handled through a Post Office Box, so personal information and anonymity are protected.
- ❖ **Provide outside AA contacts** for inside AA members who are about to be released from their facility and help aid their transition to free world AA meetings.
- ❖ **Serve as a contact** for correctional facility administrators to encourage cooperation and communication.
- ❖ **Inform outside AA members and groups** of the vital need for CFC volunteers, via regular CFC meetings, workshops, and attendance at area events.



- ❖ Be a CFC representative to your home group.
- ❖ Support the CFC Literature Fund

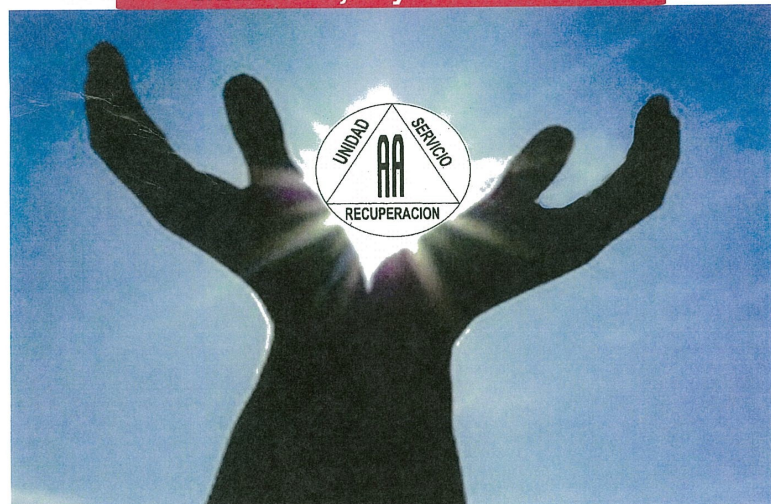
