

Cotulla Prison Meeting Growing Spiritually and in Numbers!

Often three or more English-speaking volunteers and a couple Spanish-speaking go on 2nd and 4th Saturdays into Cotulla Prison bringing Big Books for any offenders attending their *second* meeting.

With Big Books in hand, the inmates sit in small groups at tables in the prison cafeteria where they meet. Amidst the clatter and clanging of the kitchen preparations, they come up with topics and share in their groups for about 15 minutes, then share with the whole group - table by table.

Each week more inmates are coming to the meeting, growing from a dozen to a high of 70. The sharing has been powerful, and this month volunteers learned that a handful of inmates are sponsoring several of the others! The Fellowship is growing inside Cotulla Prison just as it does on the outside, ". . . when one alcoholic talks with another alcoholic, sharing experience, strength, and hope." 


