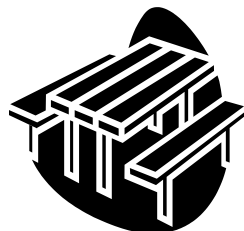

**Approval of Previous Month's Minutes:** approved as submitted

**Financial Report:** none given

**Telephone Service Report:** Christie B. announced that she is assisting John H. as co-coordinator of the volunteer phone service for the CSO. They are still in need of individuals willing to volunteer to serve as back-up for after hour's service. A Sharing Session will take place on July 25 from 1-3 p.m. at the CSO for all interested volunteers.

**Outreach Committee Report:** none

**Old Business:** The proposal of changing the name of Central Service Office to Intergroup was discussed by the Board of Trustees. The discussion concluded that a name changes would be very expensive since it would involve changes to signage, the IRS and comptroller. The Board felt it would be cost prohibitive at this time, especially as we prepare to host the International Convention. The Board asks if the COR's would consider instead changing their name from COR to CSO Representative. A motion was made by Paul B. to change the name COR's to CSO Representative. The motion was unanimously approved.


