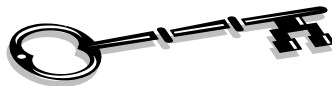

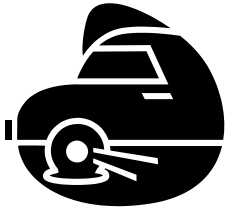

Every Monday night at 7 pm and every Thursday at 7 pm, thirty to forty men gather together and have an AA Meeting.

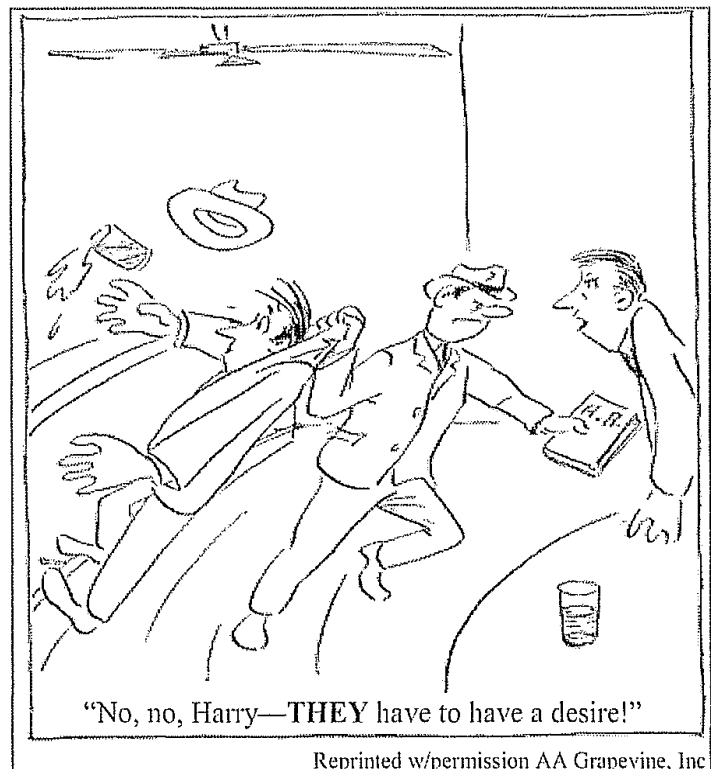
You are invited to attend. Men and women can attend this meeting

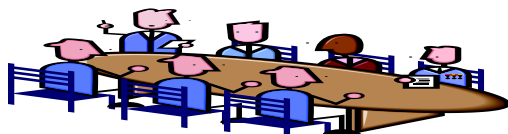
