InterService

Service work continues to thrive in San Antonio! We encourage anyone interested in service opportunities to attend the San Antonio Inter-Service workshop on April 27th. For the link to any committee meeting, please e-mail SAInterService@gmail.com Here's a brief overview of service in San Antonio:

Accessibilities: This new committee meets online each third Sunday and is currently refining their purpose statement. Most of its initial work will be focused on getting accessibilities information to the CSO. We encourage all members to attend the monthly meeting and share ideas.

Archives: San Antonio Archives is currently working on the "Things We Cannot Change" tribute to members we have lost during the pandemic. As always, we can assist in collecting the oral histories of Old Timers and group histories. This committee meets the first Thursday of the month online at 6 pm.

Corrections (CFC): The Texas Department of Criminal Justice is starting to allow in-person meetings at correctional facilities, but it is a slow process to get our schedule back on track, and we are looking for willing volunteers. Recently, the CFC committee created DVDs that can be viewed in prisons while maintaining member anonymity. We have completed over fifty hours worth of material, with much more planned. We are sharing these recordings with New York and other areas so that they might be used wherever needed.

Grapevine/ La Vina: We are delighted to celebrate the 25th birthday of La Vina this year with the publication of two new books. Our next workshop will be on June 12th from 2-3:30. Thank you to all who attended our March workshop, which was a huge success. Remember that when you purchase a subscription, you can access all back issues of the Grapevine online. Similarly, all La Vina online articles are translated into English with the click of a button. We are available to give presentations to groups and districts at their convenience. This committee meets virtually the fourth Sunday of every month at 2 pm.

PI/CPC (Public Information and Cooperation with the Professional Community): We are continuing to give presentations at Lifetime Recovery every six weeks. We are reaching out to other recovery places as well. All who are interested, please attend our monthly meeting at 12:30pm on the fourth Sunday of every month.
