- Shall not be an employee or member of the governing board of any agency licensed for the treatment of alcoholism or other addictive disorders or operated for education concerning such disorders. This restriction also applies to members of advisory boards of such agencies.
- Any Trustee serving or nominated to serve shall not be an officer or director of a club where AA meetings are regularly held.
- A former Trustee may not be appointed or elected to the Board of Trustees.
- No trustee may be elected for two (2) consecutive terms of office but may serve an appointed or elected partial term followed immediately by a full term.

Grapevine and La Viña will Celebrate Founders' Day with Free Access from May 26 through June 10!

On June 10, 1935, Dr. Bob had his last drink and that day marks the founding of Alcoholics Anonymous. 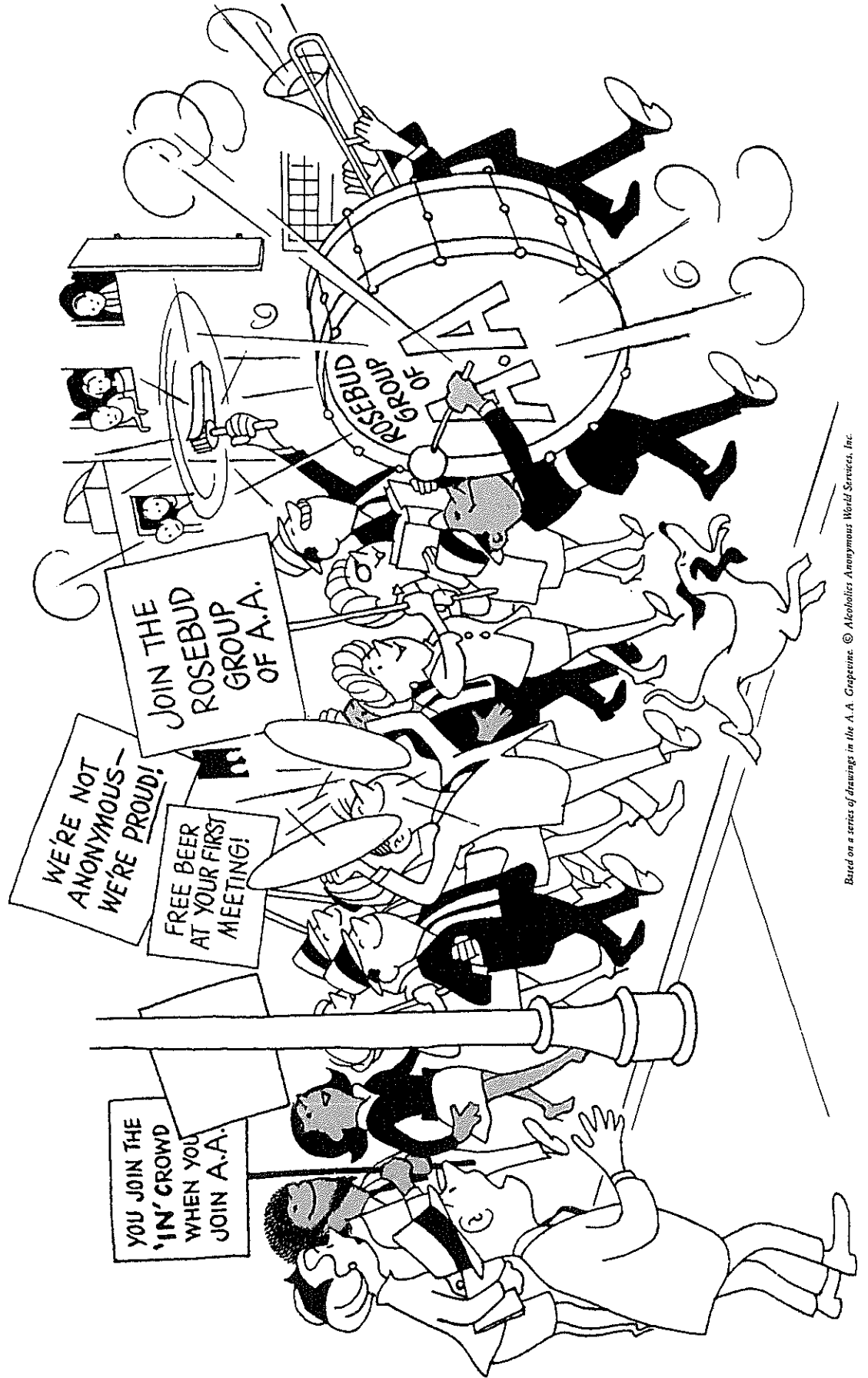

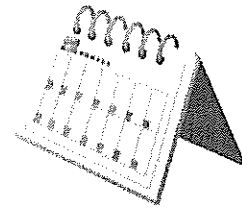
