- Any Trustee serving or nominated to serve shall not be an officer or director of a club where AA meetings are regularly held.
- A former Trustee may not be appointed or elected to the Board of Trustees.
- No trustee may be elected for two (2) consecutive terms of office but may serve an appointed or elected partial term followed immediately by a full term.

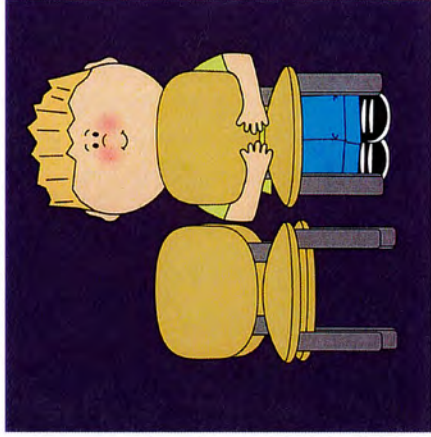

- ◆ Provides a 24-hour hotline and 12-Step call availability.
- ◆ Sells literature, sobriety tokens and lots of other merchandise to help AA groups and individual members.
- ◆ Maintains and publishes a directory of AA meetings in the Area.
- ◆ Serves as the centralized "hub" of communication for the fellowship through monthly publications Nightcap and What's Happening. Both are available through the website or you can sign up for email delivery at no charge!
