- IMPORTANT connection for inmates to AA
- Request for help before leaving prison
- First Contact support team creates support plan
- Plan to get inmate to first AA meeting outside walls

What is San Antonio Interservice

The Purpose of San Antonio Inter Service is to carry the AA message through coordination of service activities among the districts in the metropolitan service area in accordance with the Traditions and Concepts of World Service of Alcoholics Anonymous.

If you were in a treatment facility there is a good chance that AA meetings were brought in by outside AA groups, coordinated by the SAIS **Treatment Facilities Committee**. The counselors and administrative staff may have gained knowledge of AA through our Cooperation with the Professional Community Committee (**PI/CPC Committee**), through literature, newsletters, or face to face at our Area PI/CPC Conference.

If you were in jail or prison, our **Corrections Committee** probably impacted you in a similar manner or by providing Big Books, Grapevine magazines and other literature. You may have taken advantage of the Sponsor by Mail Program or Bridging the Gap upon your release. If your parole officer requires you to have a meeting attendance paper signed, it is likely that he/she or the judge have received information about Alcoholics Anonymous from either the Corrections Committee or our Cooperation with the Professional Community Committee.

As you read your issue of the Grapevine or La Vina magazine, remember that it is likely that the author wrote the story during a writing workshop which was sponsored by the local **Grapevine /La Vina Service Committee**. This valuable 12 step literature is supported solely by subscriptions and it is vital to continue to educate the fellowship and encouraging member support.

The Public Information Committee (which operates in conjunction with Cooperation with the Professional Community) continually gives presentations to students, misc. groups, rehab facilities. If your family member came home with a piece of AA Literature, it is possible that they picked it up at a local health fair where we sponsored a table stocked with pamphlets. Occasionally Public Service announcements are placed with local media. The committee is currently focused on using technology to our best advantage in carrying the message.

If you have a special need to attend a meeting such as wheelchair access, child care, etc. the **Accessibilities Committee** is constantly updating the information with Central Service Office so that you have accurate information. For the hard of hearing, online meetings seem to be preferred and these are listed separately on the website.

Many hands make light work is an old adage which rings true at San Antonio Interservice!! Your committees need you! Please consider volunteering to serve on a specific committee or to represent your home group at our monthly meeting to keep your group better informed about carrying the message in our metro area.
