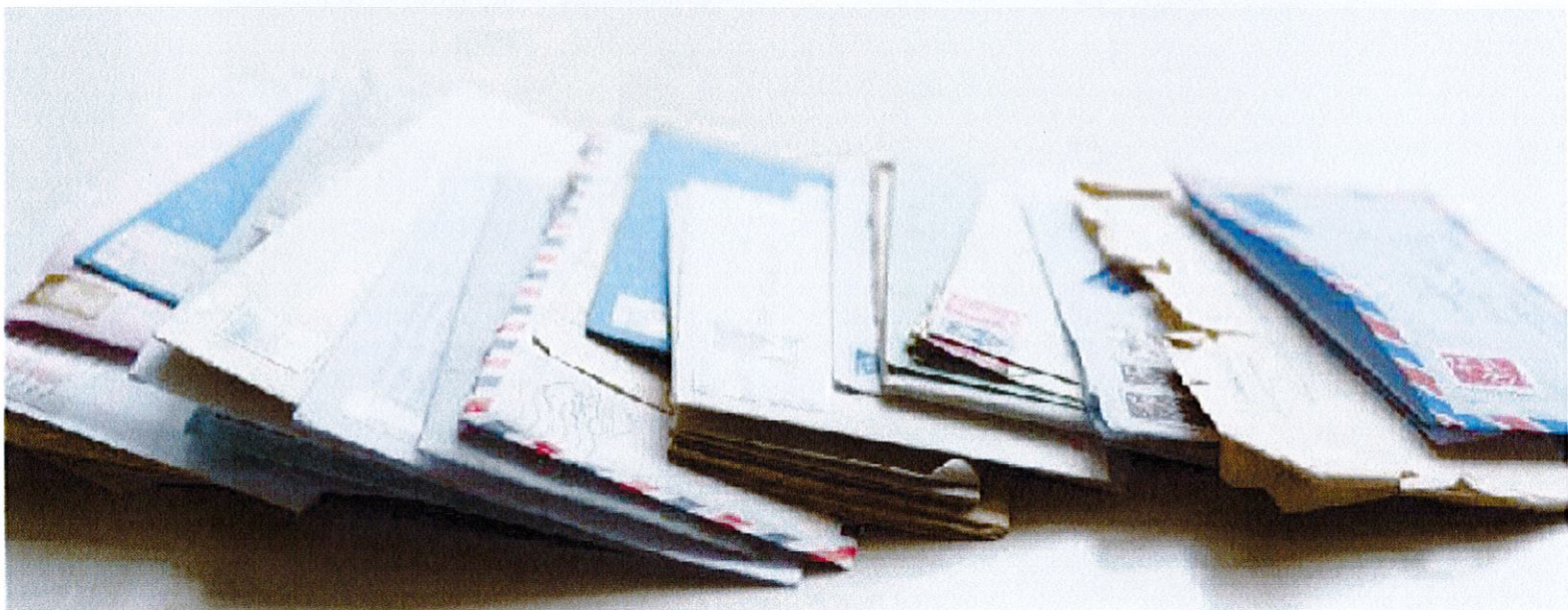
The Correctional Facilities Committee needs your help carrying the message of Alcoholics Anonymous into Prisons by mail.
