Please know that every committee (listed at end of report) are actively working to carry the message to the alcoholic that still suffers. But due to space, we will only highlight one or two each month (on a rotating basis). Our hope is that you may choose to help us in one of the AA service committees, as we are in desperate need of volunteers to help us continue to carry the message.

Statement of Purpose – The purpose of the San Antonio Inter-Service is to carry the AA message through coordination of service activities among the districts in the metropolitan service area in accordance with the Traditions and Concepts for World Service of Alcoholics Anonymous.

### Treatment Facility Committee

#### Current Service Activities

19 groups carrying the message to 15 facilities

Partnering with Grapevine & La Vina Committee to collect back issues of GV and La Vina magazines to be delivered to participating treatment facilities in San Antonio area

Bridging the Gap: AA program designed to help the alcoholic transition from the Treatment center by providing an AA contact at the point of discharge. The AA member helps the newly discharged alcoholic make contact with AA, find and attend AA meetings, and helps with the “slippery” place between the Treatment center doors and the nearest AA meeting.

To date 80 recovering alcoholics have been helped through this program!!!

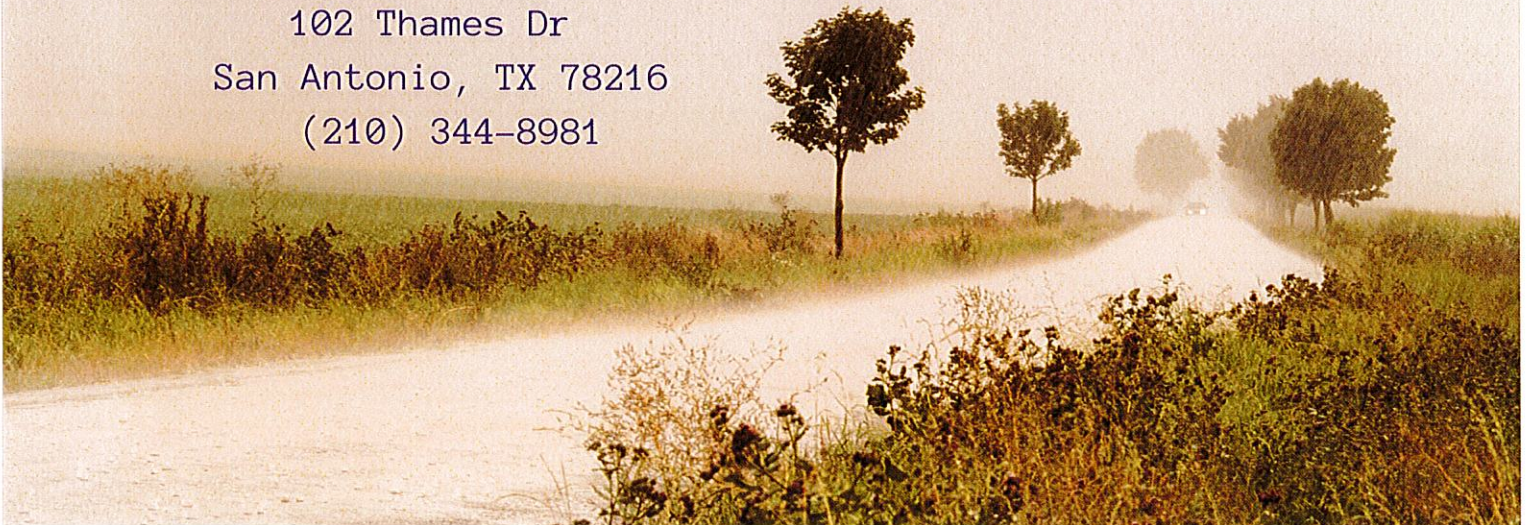

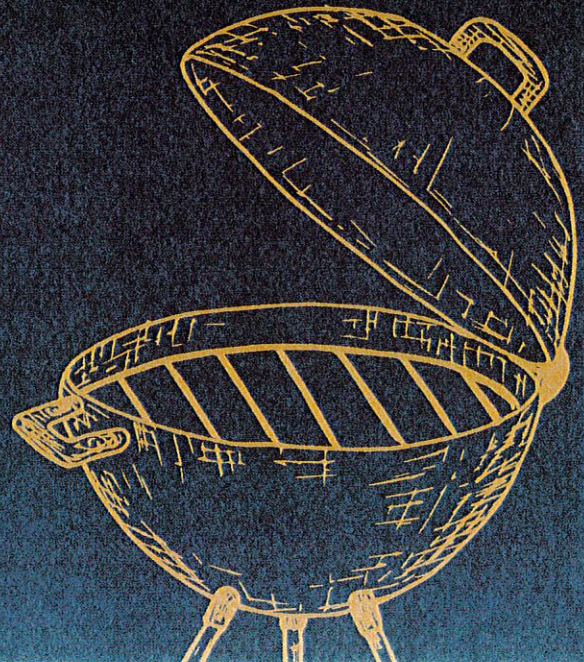

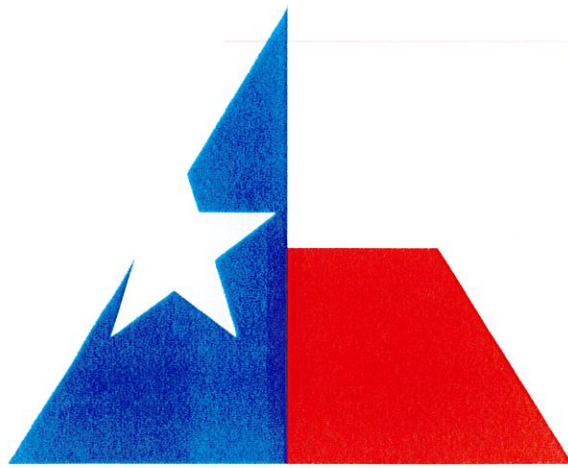

## REQUIREMENTS OF THE CSO BOARD OF TRUSTEE MEMBERS

There are seven elected Trustees. Four elected in even numbered years. Three elected in odd numbered years.

Board members must have five years or more of continuous sobriety prior to nominations. The trustees serve two year terms on the Board.

Board of Trustee meetings are held once a month on the Thursday before the third Monday at 6:00pm. Attendance is required. Missing two consecutive meetings may forfeit your position on the Board.

The Board of Trustee primary duties are:

- Developing policies for the operation of the CSOSA
- Develop and oversee CSO budget
- Non-voting member of all Board Committees
- Oversee hiring and job performance of Office Manager
- Voting member of the CSOR Meeting
- Attend functions of the Central Service Office
- Additional assignments as determined by the Board Chairperson

Additional assignments may include:

- Board Chairperson
- Vice Chairperson
- CSO Rep Liaison - monthly meeting 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of month with CSOR's
- Events Coordinator
- Financial Advisor – meet monthly with Office Manager and 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of month with CSOR's
- Hispanic Intergroup Liaison – monthly meeting with Hispanic Intergroup
- San Antonio Inter-District Liaison – monthly meeting with Inter-District
- Archives Committee Liaison – Monthly meeting with Archives Committee
- Education

Each of these assignments do require some additional time and effort. It is not a full or part time job though. And they are opportunities to be involved in areas of AA you may have little to no knowledge of. These assignments are kept for one year and then reassigned the following year. You will serve in two capacities total.

This position of service requires a commitment, and provides tremendous gratification as a service position!

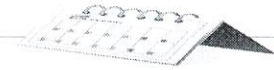
