Chairperson's Corner

WE WANT YOU ... for the next 24-hour Helpline Committee Chairperson!

The Central Service Office needs a Chairperson for the 24-Hour Helpline Committee. This is an extremely important volunteer position and helps fulfill one of the major functions of the Central Service Office. This role may be done from the comfort of your own home or from anywhere you have mobile service... from the moon or the Space Station if you'd like. You will keep an updated schedule of all volunteer phone shifts and a list of substitute phone volunteers. When new volunteers come aboard, you will help train them.

Requirements for the Helpline Chairperson are 2 years of sobriety and a current home group.

Currently, all but 2 of the phone shifts are filled. The Chairperson only needs to answer a phone shift if one of the volunteers goes on vacation and a substitute is not available for their shift.

We are also looking for CSO Phone Volunteer to take the shift below which may be done remotely. Requirements for volunteers are 1 year of sobriety, a current home group and a sponsor:

Saturdays – From 5PM – 10PM

We didn't always have SOBER members of A.A. answering the 24-hour Helpline. Prior to 1997, we paid for an answering service to take messages and pass them on to CSO.

In 1997, ALL that changed! Not only was our very own VIRGINIA B. the Chairperson for Weekend in SA with AA in 1997, but she also gave a "How-to Workshop" on the Phone System Process and Tips for Being a 24-Hour Helpline Volunteer. Here is a snapshot of what that looked like in the Nightcap from April of 1997.

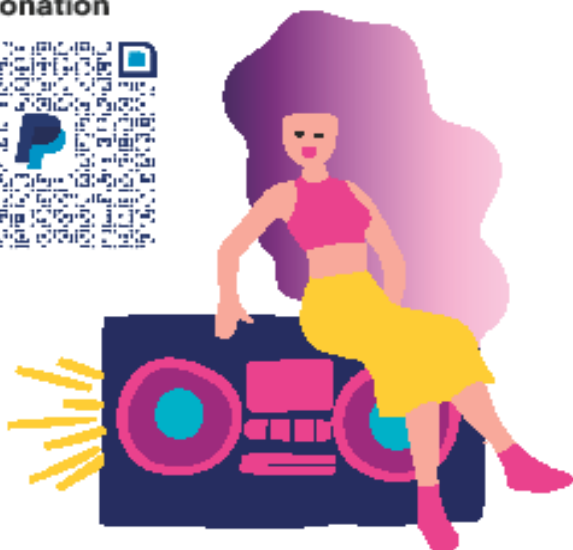

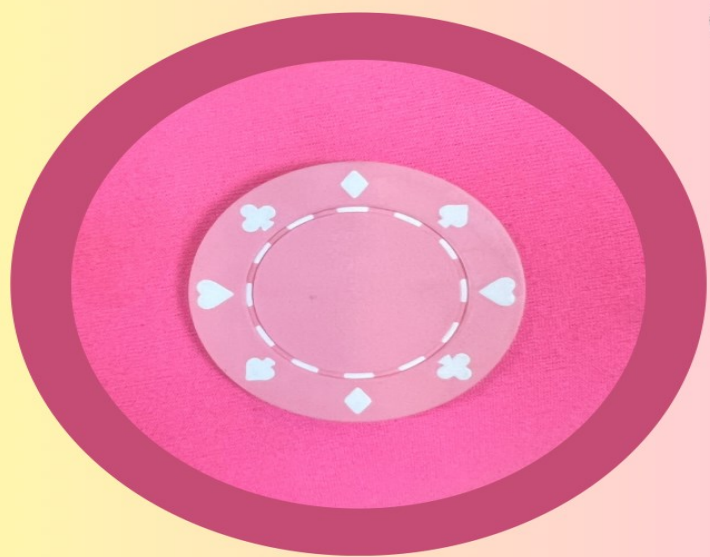

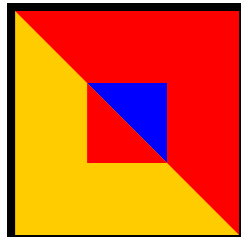
