Happy 60th Anniversary to the Big Book in French!

This year marks the 60th anniversary of the first unabridged edition of the Big Book in French, which was officially released on March 2, 1963, in Montreal, Quebec, Canada. This edition included 11 stores from the Big Book in English and eight stories of members from Quebec, France, Belgium and Switzerland. The book also contained excerpts from *Alcoholics Anonymous Comes of Age* and co-founder Bill W.'s essays on the Twelve Traditions.

The book was the culmination of efforts going back to the early 1950s to make A.A. literature available in French. These included a shorter version of the Big Book in French with only the first 11 chapters which was available as mimeographed copies for sale. Fast-forward to 1959 when the A.A. Office in Quebec created a literature committee (renamed Les Editions Francaises A.A. in 1961) to translate and publish A.A. literature in French. In 1959, the AAWS Board of Directors agreed to explore the possibility of translating the Big Book into French - and subsequently the French Big Book project was launched.

The Area 87 (Southwest Quebec) Archives Committee held a hybrid event to celebrate the anniversary.





GENERAL SERVICE OFFICE OF ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS 2025 INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. When and where will the 2025 International Convention take place? The 90th anniversary of Alcoholics Anonymous will be celebrated at the 2025 International Convention in Vancouver, BC, Canada, July 3 6, 2025.
- 2. What is the theme of the 2025 International Convention?
 The theme of the 2025 International Convention is "90 Years Language of the Heart."
- 3. Have A.A. International Conventions been held in Canada before? Yes. There have been International Conventions in Toronto (1965), Montreal (1985), and Toronto (2005). As you may know, the Responsibility Statement was adopted at the 1965 International Convention in Toronto.
- 4. Are there any restrictions or regulations affecting travel to Canada in 2025? Yes. The U.S. and Canada each have restrictions and regulations that apply to citizens and visitors who travel from one country to the other. Border crossing into Canada has significantly changed, particularly in the last two years. (For more information: access links to Canada Border Services Agency website (CBSA) provided below question #6)
- 5. Who will have to process forms and applications to gain admission to Canada? It is suggested that those who believe they have some past legal incident, such as a DUI or felony that could inhibit their attendance at the 2025 International Convention, seek assistance/information by accessing the CBSA links provided below question #6.
- 6. What Canadian travel information is currently available?

The International Convention assignment at GSO is not yet up-and-running. However, below is a resource to aid members in making plans to attend the 2025 International Convention (most questions can be answered by connecting to the links below). Also, a good travel book on Canada will provide valuable information on needed documents and border crossing requirements, as well as vacation tips.




