Chairperson's Corner

Happy Gratitude November!!!

As we move toward the end of this great year, we pause to give thanks.

November is Gratitude Month for the Central Service Office.

Collection Boxes were made and disbursed at the last CSOR meeting. Our Central Service Office is the hub for AA communications in the San Antonio Metropolitan Area. If you are unfamiliar with our local CSO, below are just a few ways the CSO carries the message.

Perhaps the Number One task of the office is answering telephone calls from thousands of members and non-members who need to contact AA. At the heart of these calls, of course, are the calls from alcoholics seeking help. We maintain a telephone listing that is available to the public and help to coordinate the helpline answered 24 hours a day, seven days a week. When someone calls, they get a live recovering alcoholic, not an answering machine. When needed we provide 12 step contacts for individuals seeking help. We maintain a listing for this purpose through cooperation with the Fellowship.

The Office maintains a listing of groups and their meetings. This is a cooperative effort with the groups from 10 Districts in South Texas. Helpline volunteers assist in locating meetings for new and current members, from San Antonio to Del Rio and East of San Antonio to Buda, Texas. The CSO can assist the districts and service committees with current Group information. Sometimes we get the information sooner than the South Texas Area Registrar.

When an AA member starts a new meeting, a new Group, the Central Service Office assists by providing information to setup a group, connects them with their District and provides the current registration form for GSO. In our bookstore, we maintain supplies the Group might need including service manuals, books, pamphlets, and chips. We even discuss the difference between closed vs open meetings and can provide information on the Traditions.

The Office functions as an information exchange between groups. We keep track of local and surrounding area events for our groups, districts, and members. The **City-Wide Calendar** is published through the **What's Happening** in San Antonio and through our newsletter, **The Nightcap**. These are emailed to over 1,400 AA members. We follow the suggested guidelines from the General Service Office regarding anonymity and the internet.

Our website **www.aasanantonio.org** is funded and maintained by the Office. It is updated daily with information for newcomers, members, and the public. In cooperation with professionals, the site is used to locate meetings for their clients or to find our office number or 24-hour helpline number. Out-of-town visitors can locate meetings through our website which **also feeds the Meeting Guide**. Meeting Guide is a free-of-charge meeting finder app owned by AAWS. The app helps people find A.A. meetings and resources near them. All A.A. service offices provide the meeting data for the app which is updated twice daily. Meeting Guide is available for iOS and Android smartphones.

We are grateful for our members who support our responsibility.
