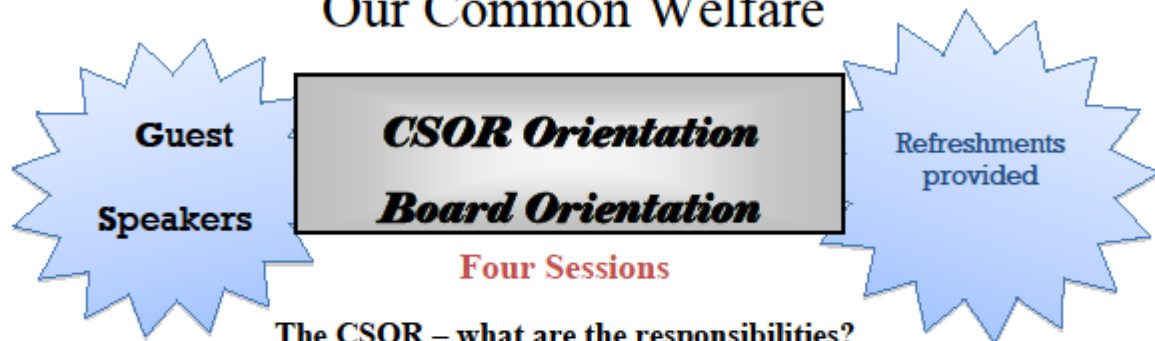

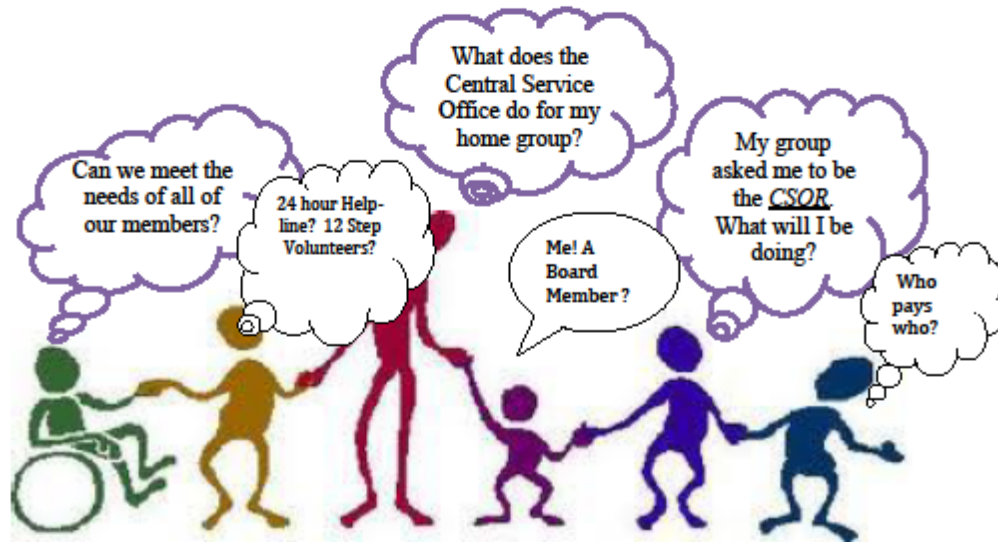

- Provides a central telephone listing under the name Alcoholics Anonymous and an office address under the name Central Service Office to receive and respond appropriately to inquires from persons seeking information.
- Provides a 24-hour hotline and 12-step call availability.
- Sells literature, sobriety tokens and lots of other merchandise to help AA groups and individual members.
- Serves as the centralized “hub” of communication for the fellowship through monthly publications Nightcap and What’s Happening. Both are available through the website, or you can sign up for email delivery at no charge. Printed copies are available at CSO at no charge.
- Can make copies of your event flyers, meeting agendas, minutes and more! (cheaper than Kinkos!)
- Maintains a speaker list if your meeting needs a speaker.
