2022 Membership Survey Results Are Available !

More than 6,000 A.A. members were randomly selected and surveyed in 2022 by the General Service Office for the U.S. and Canada. The Membership Survey, which has been conducted periodically since 1968, provides a snapshot of the A.A. fellowship and its members. The last one was done in 2014. This survey is not a census. The survey results may be of interest to the professional community, the media, and the general public — anyone who wants to know more about A.A. in keeping with the primary purpose of A.A. to carry the message to those who suffer from alcoholism. For the first time questions about on-line meetings were asked.

Members had the option to take the survey in English, French, or Spanish. For the first time, selected groups had the option to take the survey online instead of the traditional pen-and-paper method. 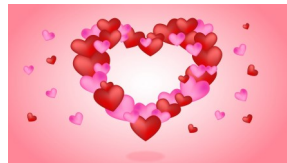

Embracing Our Collective Conscience: A Reflection on the Second Tradition

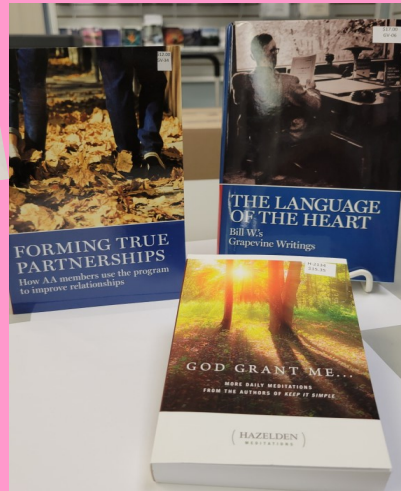

Tradition Two reminds us, "For our group purpose there is but one ultimate authority — a loving God as He may express Himself in our group conscience. Our leaders are but trusted servants; they do not govern." This profound statement is not just a guideline for group meetings; it's a beacon that illuminates our path to recovery and personal growth.

In the tapestry of our shared experiences, each thread is equally important, weaving a fabric of support that holds us together. Tradition Two underscores the essence of equality and mutual respect within our fellowship. 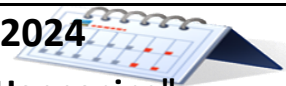
Ben F. adjourned the meeting with the Responsibility Statement.
