One of the vital services provided by your CSO is the 24-hour helpline which is answered by a volunteer alcoholic member rather than by an answering service. The local fellowship has always felt that having an alcoholic answering the phones is important, as we can immediately identify with the still suffering alcoholic who reaches out to us for help.

Our shifts run from 9 am – 1 pm, 1 pm to 5 pm, 5 pm – 10 pm and 10 pm – 9 am 7 days a week. Most volunteers transfer the calls to their cell or home number giving them the flexibility to accomplish things at home, while others come into the office during the daytime and “man” the helpline desk in front. Some callers simply want meeting information, but with that information readily available online, many calls are from people who are still drinking and don’t know what to do to quit.

Here is where our 12 Step volunteers are important, as they can engage in a lengthier conversation with the individual, while the helpline volunteer can keep an open line to help other callers.

We also have a list of phonline substitutes who make themselves available occasionally should a regular shift worker need a day off.

We currently have a need for more volunteers to cover shifts, act as substitutes and serve on the 12-step list. We also need a coordinator for the after-hours shifts.

If this sounds like a service that you could provide, please call the office (210) 821-6235. Training is provided and a detailed manual is available.

April's Beacon of Service: Nurturing Recovery and Unity

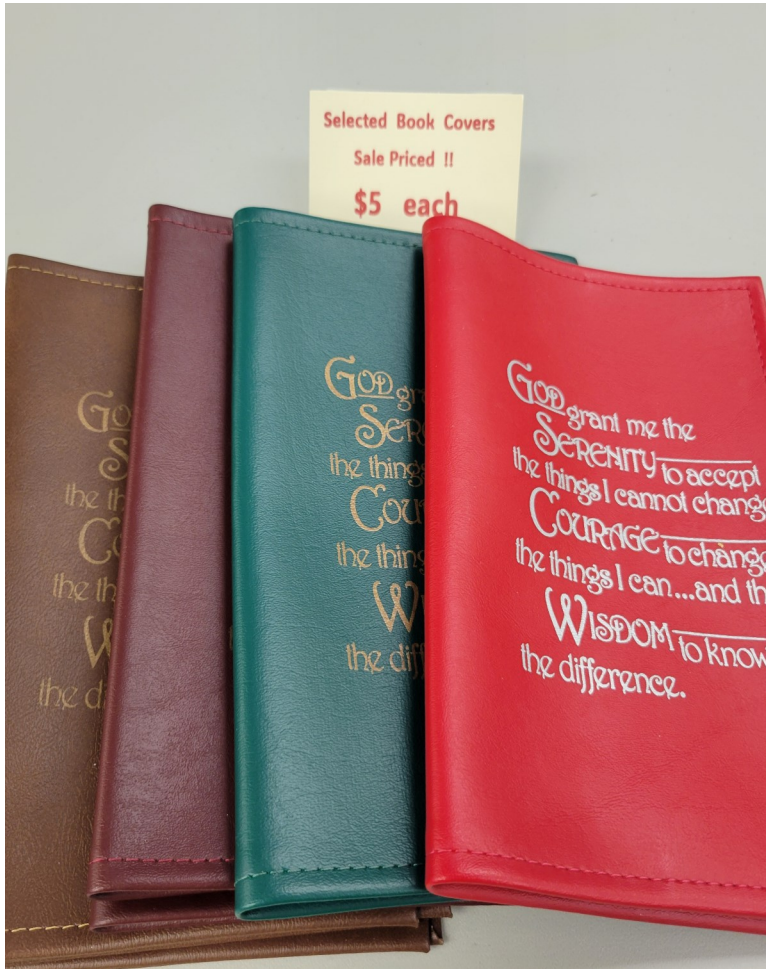

In the spirit of renewal, may we all find new ways to contribute, share, and celebrate the transformative power of service in our lives and the lives of those around us.

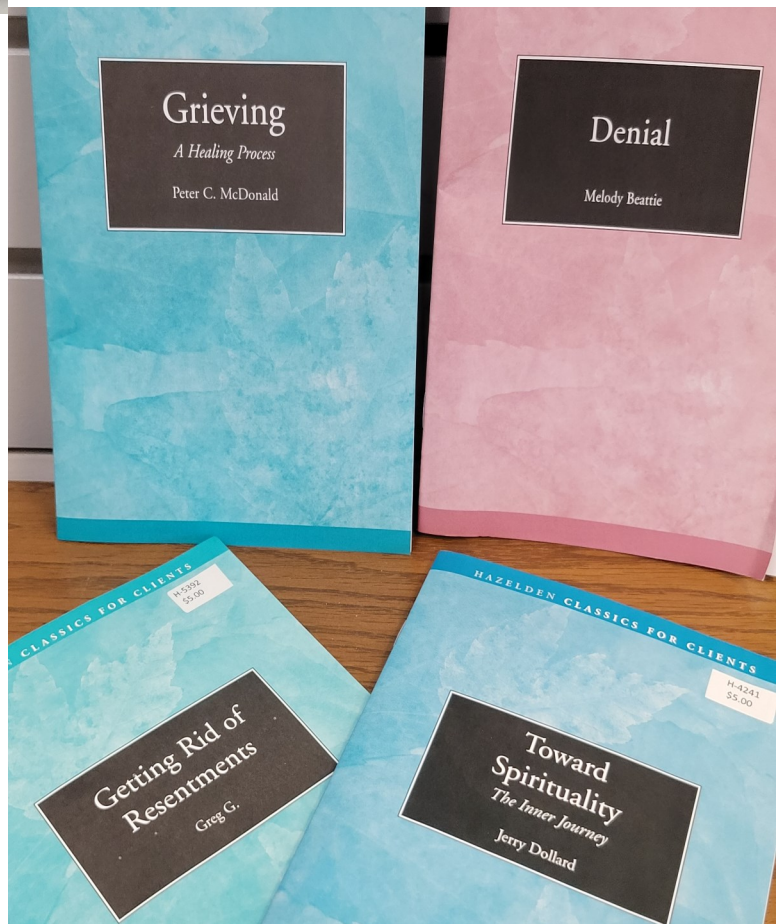
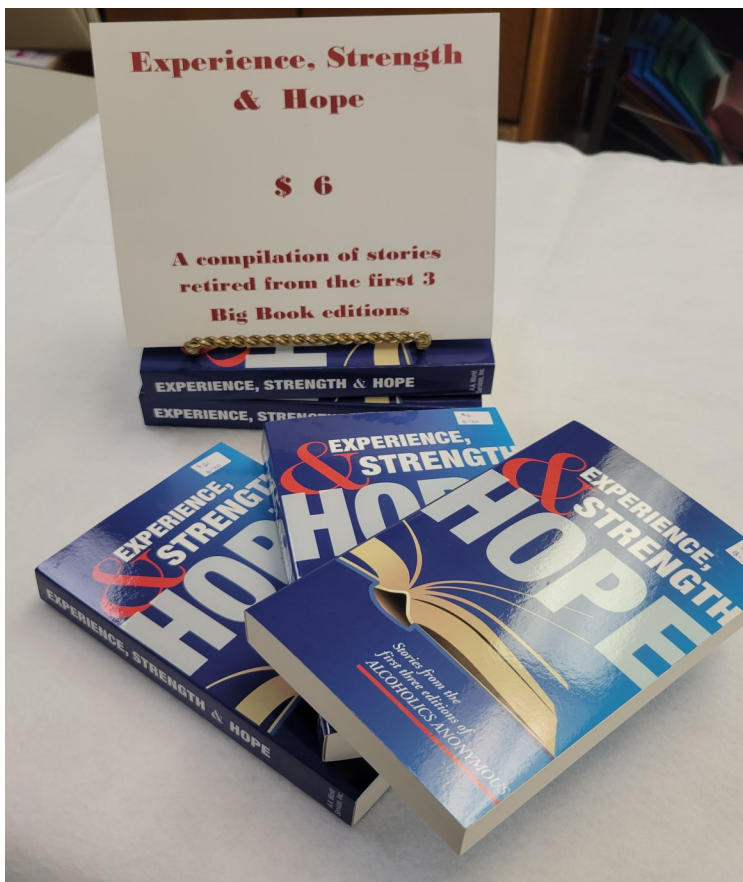
