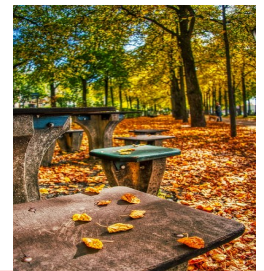

PHONE VOLUNTEERS

- We will have to have all changes by Friday at noon so we can program them for the next week. We can still accommodate emergencies.

24 HOUR HELP LINE VOLUNTEER

One of the most fulfilling service commitments that exist in AA

Help line volunteers agree to cover a regular set time (shift) weekly to be available to answer calls which come into the helpline number. This can be done remotely from home, or they can come into the Central Service Office to answer the calls. Substitutes are always welcome to cover shifts on an as needed basis as well.

Calls range in variety from a member looking for a meeting, to a family member asking about AA, to a still suffering newcomer ready to embark on the journey of sobriety. Often people newly released from the correctional system ask for guidance in attending their first meeting outside the walls.

An office staff member will meet with the new volunteer to review our Guidelines Manual and answer any questions they may have.

Substitutes are available if they are unable to cover your shift on a certain day.

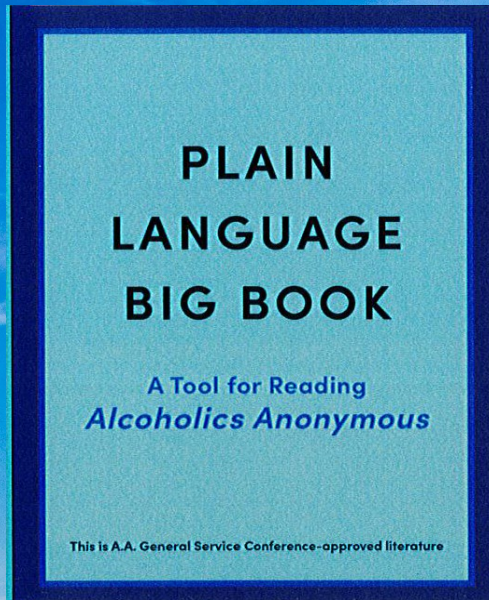
It is suggested that volunteers have one year of sobriety to do telephone service work, but this can be waived if you have a sponsor or other experienced back up person to call upon if you need help in handling a call. Office staff are always available to help during business hours.
