I could never have done it without the countless people who shared in meetings, spoke to me before or after, or reached out with a call or text. My sponsors spent endless hours on the phone, listening to me cry about how “unfair” life was.

So, when I say it's humbling and an honor to serve as Chair of the Central Service Office (CSO) Board, please know that “humbling” and “honor” doesn't even begin to express how I feel.

The CSO holds a special place in my heart and my story. The kindness of those working and volunteering there when I visited always lifted my spirits. Many times, I showed up pretending to look for something to buy simply because I didn't want to be alone. Looking back, I suspect they knew and were happy to share a little of their light with me. It's my hope that as your Chair this year, I can follow their example and pass on some of that light to others.

Tradition One reads:

Our common welfare should come first. Personal recovery depends upon AA unity.

Here at Central Service Office, we try to foster unity between all local AA entities by supporting them through the newsletters and by sponsoring a forum (the monthly CSO Rep meeting) where all groups can come together to share needs, concerns, and new ideas and activities. We truly are **your** office and it is a pleasure to do what we can to support our groups as best we can. That is why it is important to have group representation – so that we can be responsive to your needs.

Unity must be coupled with communication. Sometimes, however, it seems that we now have so many different ways to communicate that we don't communicate at all! It took a while for us to realize that 12 step volunteers weren't answering help line volunteer calls because the number came up as unrecognizable. We began texting instead.

In this fast changing world, how can we best reach the still suffering alcoholic? We rely on you for constant input and discussion!

To apply this tradition to your personal life, take a minute this month to contemplate the following questions from the AA Grapevine Traditions Checklist:

1. Am I in my group a healing, mending, integrating person? Am I sometimes divisive? Do I ever gossip or take another member's inventory?
2. Am I a peacemaker? Or do I foster arguments with statements such as "just for the sake of discussion"?
3. Am I gentle with those who rub me the wrong way, or am I sometimes abrasive?
4. Do I make competitive AA remarks, such as comparing one group with another or contrasting AA in one place with AA in another?
5. Do I ever put down some AA activities for not participating in this or that aspect of AA?
6. Am I informed about AA as a whole? Do I support AA as a whole in every way I can, or just the parts that I understand and approve of?
7. Am I as considerate of AA members as I want them to be of me?
8. Do I spout platitudes about love while indulging in and secretly justifying behavior that bristles with hostility?

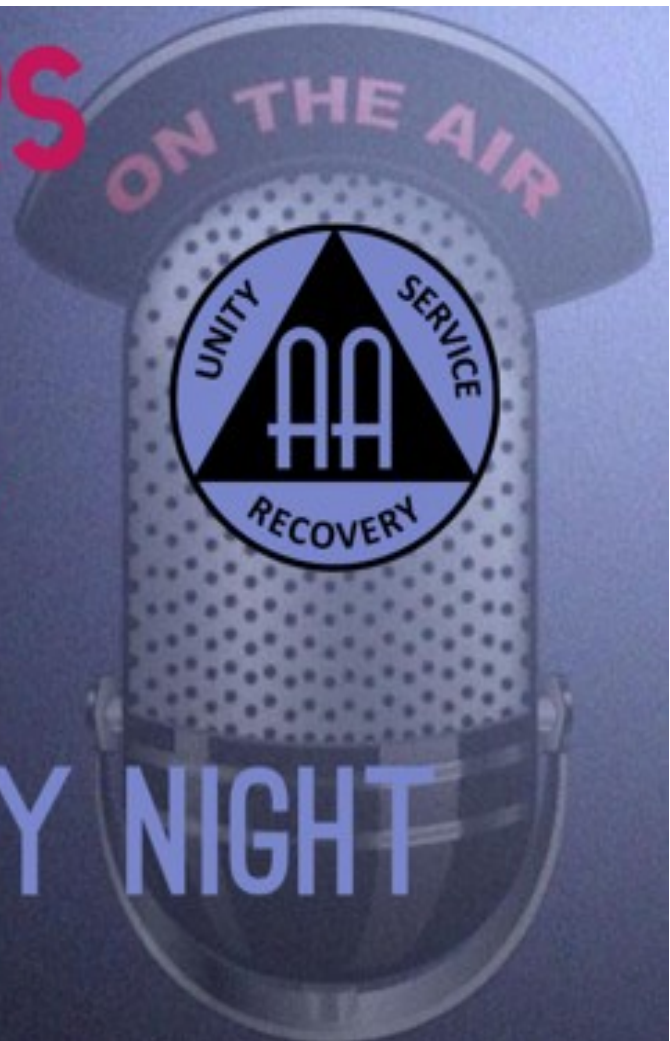

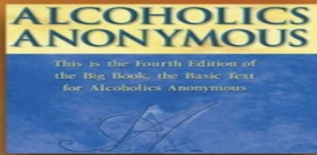

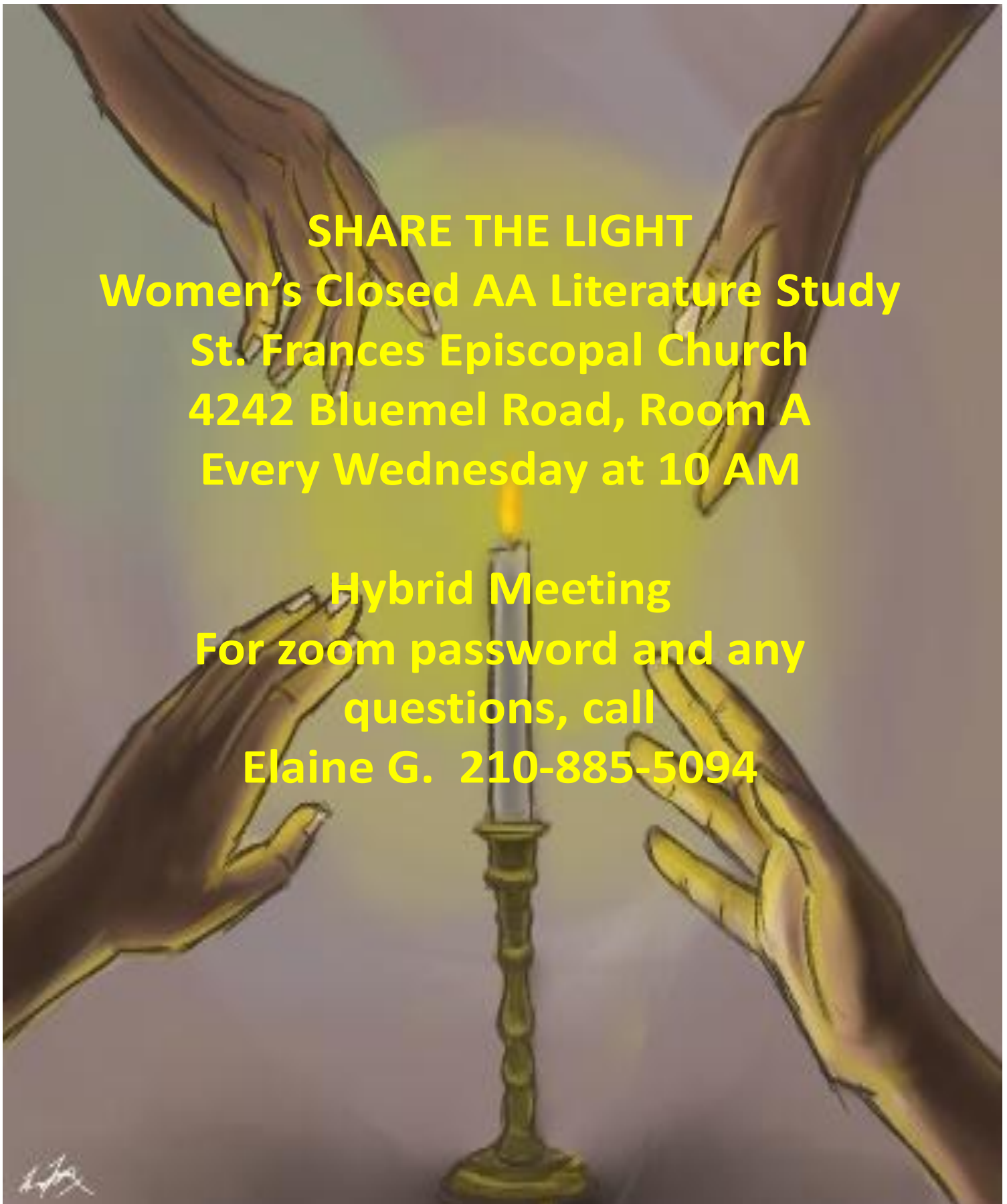
