PHONE DUTY HINTS

Here are some suggestions for after hours phone duty. These directions were put together in a simple way, to make phone the transfers easy for all. Please, take time to read them over, if you have any questions, call on those listed below. They will be happy to help.

"I am responsible. When anyone, anywhere, reaches out for help, I want the hand of A.A. always to be there. And for that: I am responsible."

No longer will an alcoholic call us and get an answering service manned by non-alcoholics. This system uses **Remote Call Forwarding** and is serviced 100% by volunteers in service like you. Only when necessary, **Call Notes** backs up our answering effort. Remember, Remote Call Forwarding and Call Notes are two separate functions!

When you are ready to begin your duty time, find out if the phone is already forwarded by *calling the Help Line number yourself (828-6235)*. If the previous person is still on duty, tell them you will now take

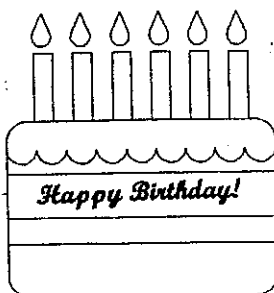
