HOW TO GET A TAX I.D. NUMBER FOR YOUR AA GROUP

We frequently get calls from AA Groups who want to open checking accounts in the group name and not have to use an individual's Social Security number. The following is a simplified set of instructions on how to get a Tax I.D.# without filling out forms so complex that they'd confound a veteran CPA.

- 1). Call 1-800-829-1040 (toll free) and ask the IRS to send you form SS-4 for non-profit organizations. Explain that you only want the tax identification number for banking purposes. Give the IRS your name and address for mailing the form to you.
- 2). Fill out the SS-4 form when it arrives. If you have any questions, call 1-800-829-1040 again and ask for help in completing the form. (It really is quite simple.)
- 3). When your form is completed, call 816-926-5999 (NOT toll free). The IRS will give you your tax identification over the phone. Put the tax identification on the upper right hand corner of the Form SS-4 and make a copy of the form for your group's records.
- 4). Mail the completed SS-4 Form to the address in Kansas City, MO that they give you.

Now you have a Tax Identification number to take to the bank to open a checking or savings account in the group name.

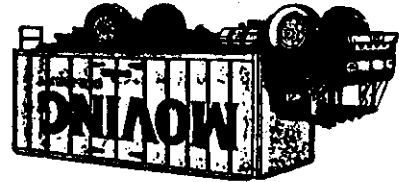
