COR Meeting – Minutes (02/21/99)

Dewey S opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer. Linda U read the Twelve Traditions. Dewey read the COR Guidelines. The sign-in sheet was passed around. One new COR present: Ed C. alternate COR for The New Downtown Group. The minutes from the last COR meeting were accepted as printed in the Nightcap.

Convention Report: Tomi reported that flyers with names and phone numbers of all committee chairpersons are available in case groups or individuals want to volunteer to help. Special need for clean-up volunteers since we are in a much bigger place, Scottish Rite, with a huge kitchen (holds 1500). We got good publicity at the Coastal Bend Jamboree in Corpus Christi last weekend where AA in SA was announced to over 1100 people. There are a variety of ways to register, including credit cards and the AA in SA webpage. Scholarships are available. See the registration chairperson, David W for more information. There will be a spaghetti supper at Club 12 on March 19 for \$4/plate as a fund-raiser for scholarships. Question was asked by Ron what was needed most: money, volunteers, food, etc. Answer was that right now they need help with all of it.

Financial Report: Wayne was unable to attend, so David W gave the financial report. He asked if there were any specific questions about the report. There were none. We are within a few cents of our budget. Also, the physical inventory had been completed last month and that was reflected in the financial statement.

Telephone Service Committee Report: Kim C reported that the new telephone service packets are not ready yet because the Twelfth Step List call-down is still in progress. We still need volunteers to help with the call-down to make the Twelfth Step List more accurate. Several CORs volunteered and were given numbers to call. The March calendar was passed around. A few time slots are still available in February. For the first time since the TSC was formed, there will be no marathon meeting on telephone service work this year at the Convention. A stand-alone workshop is being planned for sometime in the early summer. There was a brief explanation of telephone service work and CORs were told that both groups and individuals could sign up for as few or as many time slots as they wanted. Colonies North and Group 12 have each taken a week in March. More volunteers for after-hours telephone service work are urgently needed. Call Kim at 522-0488 to volunteer.

Old Business: Bill H, chairperson of the Nightcap Committee, reported that a committee has been formed but has not as yet taken any action. There are several activities in the planning stages. Several subscriptions have been made since last month via direct contact with committee members. Question from Ron about if we could have a dedicated Nightcap booth at the Convention. David reminded us that we already have a CSO booth where Nightcap subscriptions are available. There was discussion by Bill and others that since other business will be conducted there, a table specific to the Nightcap might be a good idea. Tomi and Bill will discuss that possibility. Dewey noted that his Nightcap arrived on Feb 2. Bonnie at CSO had attached a sheet to the COR agenda showing the mail-out dates for each Nightcap for the last year to show that late arrivals are more the exception than the norm. Dewey stated that CSO will stick to the deadline date of the 21st of each month, except for a month like the current one where the COR minutes will not be given to CSO until the 22nd. He also emphasized the importance of accurate addresses for CORs and GSRs because of the added cost of returned Nightcaps. If returned even once, that address will be deleted. Ron asked for an exact count of who all received their Nightcaps on Feb 2. By a show of hands, about half did receive it by that date and 3 or 4 did not receive it at all, with the others present not saying either way. David asked those who did not receive their mailing to check their addresses on the sign-in sheet and note the same, so that the problem can be corrected.

New Business: None.

Announcements: None.

Dewey passed the hat. Motion made and seconded to adjourn.

Having spent many years of my sobriety working on my humility, I realised that I had inadvertently blanked out the fact that I possess a towering intellect, which I will call TI.

This made me feel a touch guilty because, if I had added my incisive bent for lateral thinking (LT), I could have solved a number of local AA problems.

Anxious to make up for lost time, I quizzed a few group secretaries on the major difficulties facing us as we approach the Millennium. Unsurprisingly, they unanimously agreed them to be:

A - getting members to wash up after meetings;

B - selling the SHARE magazines that enthusiastic Liaison Officers have persuaded groups to buy.

Obviously a great opportunity to test my burgeoning TI plus LT (TILT).

At my home group, everyone stands around after the meeting and chats. No one helps wash up. Sound familiar, does it? My solution was to persuade the Secretary to call for volunteers to stand around chatting...

Unwilling to be publicly identified as idlers, the entire group demanded the right to wash up. There were minor injuries as they fought to get to the kitchen. And one J-cloth got torn in seven.

To accommodate subsequent demand, the GSR permits some cups to be washed and dried twice. Although there remains a bit of a melee, the TILT solution is working well.

Selling SHARE was a doddle. I simply offered them at one pound each, warning members that if they bought them at any other meeting they would be compelled to pay 70p. Everyone likes to be different and they all went in a trice. Another member has now started selling them at 70p and they go very quickly too because some members like to be different from those who are different.

I was quite keen to extend my range with TILT but, for reasons which baffle me, my sponsor has suggested I return to burnishing my humility.

He may of course be right.

Serve no purpose for her. **Shawn S.** - Ditto what Barbi just said. **Tommy B-A** - If it is necessary, why is CSO doing something for us. Why is not our secretary doing it? **Glenn C.** - Said the question of the reminder cards came up when he was on the Board of CSO, and it was voted at that time to continue to do it as it did not cost that much, and might serve some. He asked for anyone in attendance to raise their hands if they used the cards as a reminder. No one raised their hand. He pointed out that the Traditions indicate that the Groups donate to SAMSO to be self-supporting and to do what it is purposed to do. The same holds true for the Group donations sent to the Central Service Office. **Lynne G.** made a motion, "To recommend to the Board of the Central Service Office to discontinue the sending of the postal reminder cards, and to continue to split the rent." **Rocky S.** seconded the motion. Though Tradition Nine at first seems to deal with a purely practical matter, in its actual operation it discloses a society without organization, animated only by the spirit of service—a true fellowship.
